

The 2011 Enid Ornament is focused around major icons in the community. Center Stage is the David Allen Memorial Ball Park. The Ball Park has brought

major commerce into Enid over the last several years and received national recognition by hosting the Junior College World Series. To the left is the Broadway Tower. It was built in 1931 and is the tallest building in the Enid skyline at 14 stories. To the right you see the Mashall Building originally part of Phillips University now Northern Oklahoma College. The Marshall Building is a key silhouette to all who travel to Enid from the East.



The waving wheat sits down in the center, offset by a grain elevator and oil derrick; all representing key components of the Enid economy. The jet flying in the blue sky above Enid signifies the vital impact that Vance Air Force Base has on our community.
